CALL FOR VOLUNTEER TRAFFIC MARSHALS

WOMADelaide is looking for volunteers to join the traffic management team during WOMADelaide 2019. Our traffic marshals will be rostered for daytime and evening shifts throughout the bump-in, running and bump-out of the Festival from 4/3/19 until 14/3/19 inclusive.

Volunteers who complete five rostered shifts of 4hrs each will receive complimentary admission to WOMADelaide throughout the four days of the Festival.

Volunteers will need to be comfortable working outdoors, have excellent knowledge of Adelaide generally and the local roads that surround Botanic Park and have good availability between 4/3/19 and 14/3/19. Traffic management volunteers must also have appropriate confidence to enforce the Festival's vehicle policies and procedures, and give clear directions to drivers, contractors and the public.

Duties will include:

- Admitting authorised vehicles and personnel onto Botanic Park
- Refusing site entry to unauthorised vehicles, pedestrians and cyclists, and provide courteous explanations and advice about alternative routes
- Administering WOMADelaide's system of delivery passes, vehicle grass passes and event parking passes
- Using a two-way radio to receive directions from the traffic coordinator and the site management team as required

While an umbrella & chair will be provided at each gate position, traffic marshals will be required to spend a significant proportion of each shift standing and walking to speak with the drivers of vehicles. It will be essential to wear comfortable closed-toe footwear and a secure broad-brimmed sun-hat each day, and bring a jumper, rain jacket & a personal water-bottle. WOMADelaide will provide traffic marshals with a high-vis vest, a crew tee-shirt, sunscreen and water to refill water bottles.

All traffic marshals will receive WHS inductions and job training in Botanic Park during the week beginning 25/2/19.
